

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FROM THE TEACHING STAFF OF SCHOOL OF BUSINESS: SUPPORT TO PUBLISH PAPERS IN PEER-REVIEWED INTERNATIONAL JOURNALS

The UR-Sweden Programme 4th Phase (2019-2024) has limited funds to support the teaching staff of School of Business to publish papers in peer-reviewed international journals. The conditions of eligibility for funding to publish papers are as follows:

- 1. A written application addressed to the Principal, CBE and a copy to the Team Leader, Sustainable Management Research Sub-Program
- 2. Must be a teaching staff of the CBE's School of Business
- 3. The letter of acceptance of the manuscript to be published by the journal
- 4. The journal or publisher should not be a predatory one that is interested in collecting Article Processing Charges (APC)/ fees
- 5. The manuscript of the paper in the proper word format both print and soft
- 6. Details of the proper proforma invoice for APC and/or publication
- 7. The paper must have less than 10% similarity score tested with Turntin
- 8. The website where Journal details can be accessed.
- 9. Funding conditions: The SoB academic staff to be supported with publication fees if the article is accepted in a peer-reviewed indexed journal with an impact factor in the concerned discipline.
- 10. Under the present call, a faculty member of the SoB can only be supported to publish one research paper. Each paper shall receive a funding of 75000 RWF (Seventy-five thousand Rwandan Francs).

The applications shall be received up to 31st December 2021 and will be screened as and when received until the funds are exhausted. The CBE College Research Screening and Ethics Clearance committee appointed by the Principal, CBE shall advise the principal-CBE either accept or reject the paper for the support. Incomplete applications shall be rejected.
